COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

- Council held a regular meeting on October 8th.
- The Recreation Liaison position will be increased to 12 hours per week.
- The Town agreed to the Delisle and District Health Council's request to increase the per capita levy from \$2.00 to \$3.00 for 2020.
- A new Arena User Group policy was adopted and will be circulated to the user groups.
- A separate special savings account will be set up at the Delisle Credit Union for funds raised for the Splash Park project.
- The second and final lift of pavement for the 100 Block of 6th Avenue East will be completed in 2020. This will allow for any settling that may occur from all the excavation work that was done.
