COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

- Town Council held a regular meeting on February 11th.
- The Town will purchase a new bucket for the New Holland tractor.
- The Town approved the temporary road closure of 2nd Avenue by the new ball diamonds on Sunday, March 8th from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in order to accommodate Winter Fest festivities.
- On behalf of VMAD (Emergency Measures Organization), the R.M. of Montrose will apply for funding under the provincial Targeted Sector Support Initiative.
- The Town will pay for 50% of the cost of installing water and sewer services to the property line of the Early Learning Center including the installation of a new fire hydrant to a maximum cost to the Town of \$13,000, PST included.
- The Town will apply for funding under the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program for the replacement of the sewage lift station and accompanying force main located on Valleyview Drive. The project is estimated to cost \$1,920,000. The Town's share of this cost will be roughly over 25% which will be primarily funded through long term borrowing.
- The Town will also apply, under this same program, for the construction of a splash park on Lot 4, Block 31 at an estimated cost of \$300,000. The Town's roughly 25% share of this cost is already covered through cash reserves from fundraising plus third party commitments. However, there are no guarantees whatsoever of receiving any grant funding for either the lift station project or the new splash park.
- The administrator was directed to begin proceedings to have the splash park property designated as a Municipal Reserve.
- The Town will purchase additional Cyber insurance through Hub International Ltd.
- The administrator was authorized to initiate tax enforcement proceedings against the following properties:
 - 1) Lot 6, Block 11, Plan G11
 - 2) Lot 5, Block 13, Plan G11
 - 3) Lot 21, Block 21, Plan 77S38002
 - 4) Lot 2, Block 24, Plan 65S16551
